

Q: How do I get my USATF Level 1 Track & Field Coach Certification? A: Starting in January 2025, the Level 1 program is now offered as a hybrid/blended course—about half online and half "in-person." <u>Register</u> for the self-based/online portion. Upon completion, you will be eligible to attend the two-day live seminar to complete the requirements.

Q: The Level 1 certification I earned at Canby High School, University of Portland, Pacific University, or St. Mary's High School is outdated. How do I recertify? A: It depends on how outdated it is. If it has lapsed, you will have to retake the Level 1 course in the new format. If you are current, you can take some continuing education and there are many options <u>here</u>.

Q: When and where is the next USATF Level 2 Track & Field Coach Certification School?

A: The Level 2 program is currently under reconfiguration and will return as a hybrid/blended course in December 2025. The new format will be more accessible as it reduces the in-person seminar to 2.5 days from the former weeklong schedule.
